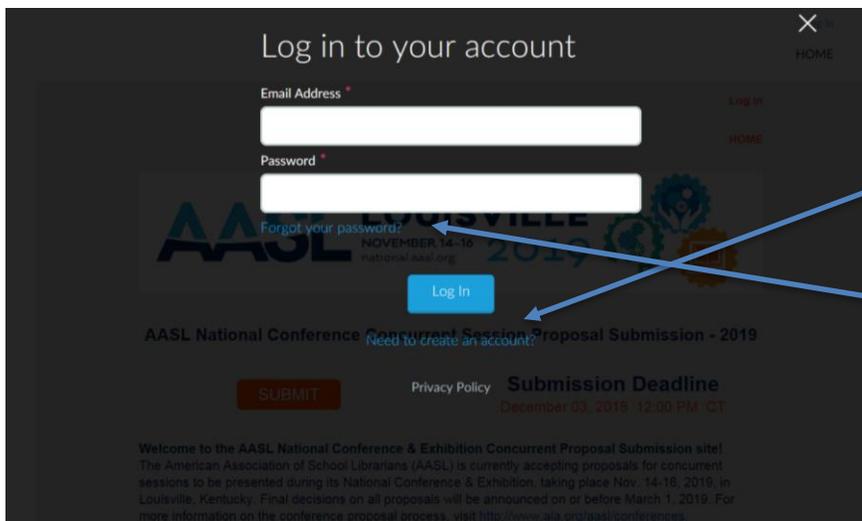


IdeaLab 2019 Submission Instructions



If you have not created or started an IdeaLab submission, click “Begin Submission.” You will be required to create a new account.

If you have already started a proposal, click “Log In” in the upper right-hand corner.



This is not linked to your ALA account.

If you need to create an account, click “Need to create an account?”

If you forget your password, please choose “Forgot your password?” AASL will not have log in credentials.



To start a new submission, click “BEGIN SUBMISSION.”

To access previously started submissions or submissions that have been submitted, click “My Submissions.” You will have access to edit submissions until 3/18/19 at noon CT.

Page 3: This is where the meat of your proposal goes. What you enter here will be scored by reviewers. Please be detailed. All proposals undergo a **blind review**.

A few things to note:

- 1) Please choose a concise Session Title!
- 2) You will be logged out automatically if you are inactive for a long period of time. Remember to save often.
- 3) These are the new strands for the IdeaLab. You may only choose 2 strands. If the strands look unfamiliar, you can learn more about them on the AASL website at <https://standards.aasl.org/>
- 4) This * denotes a required field.
- 5) The program outline and descriptions have a **character** limit. You may want to create your description in a different program to track this limit.
- 6) You must create a learning objective.
- 7) You will need to have text in all of the required * fields before you will be able to exit. You can enter gibberish text in here until you are ready to complete the field.
- 8) You will not receive a higher score for uploading images and whether or not you need a monitor for presenting.

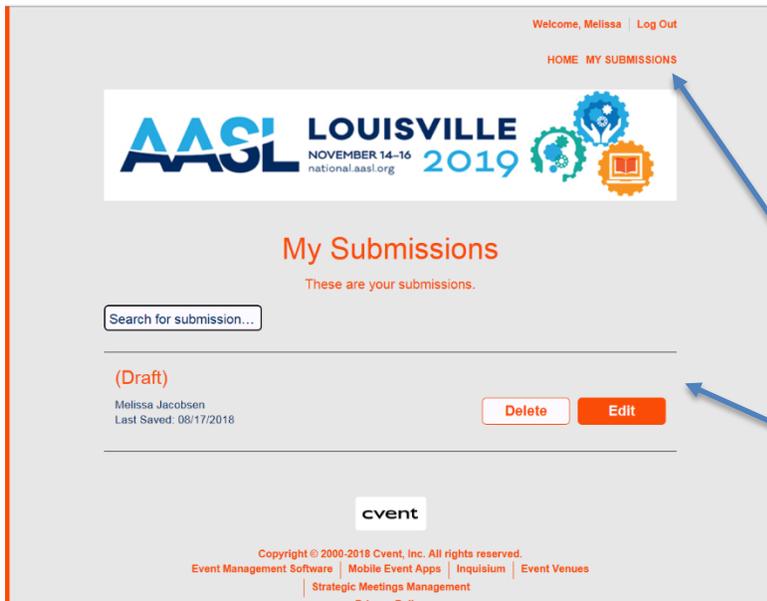
